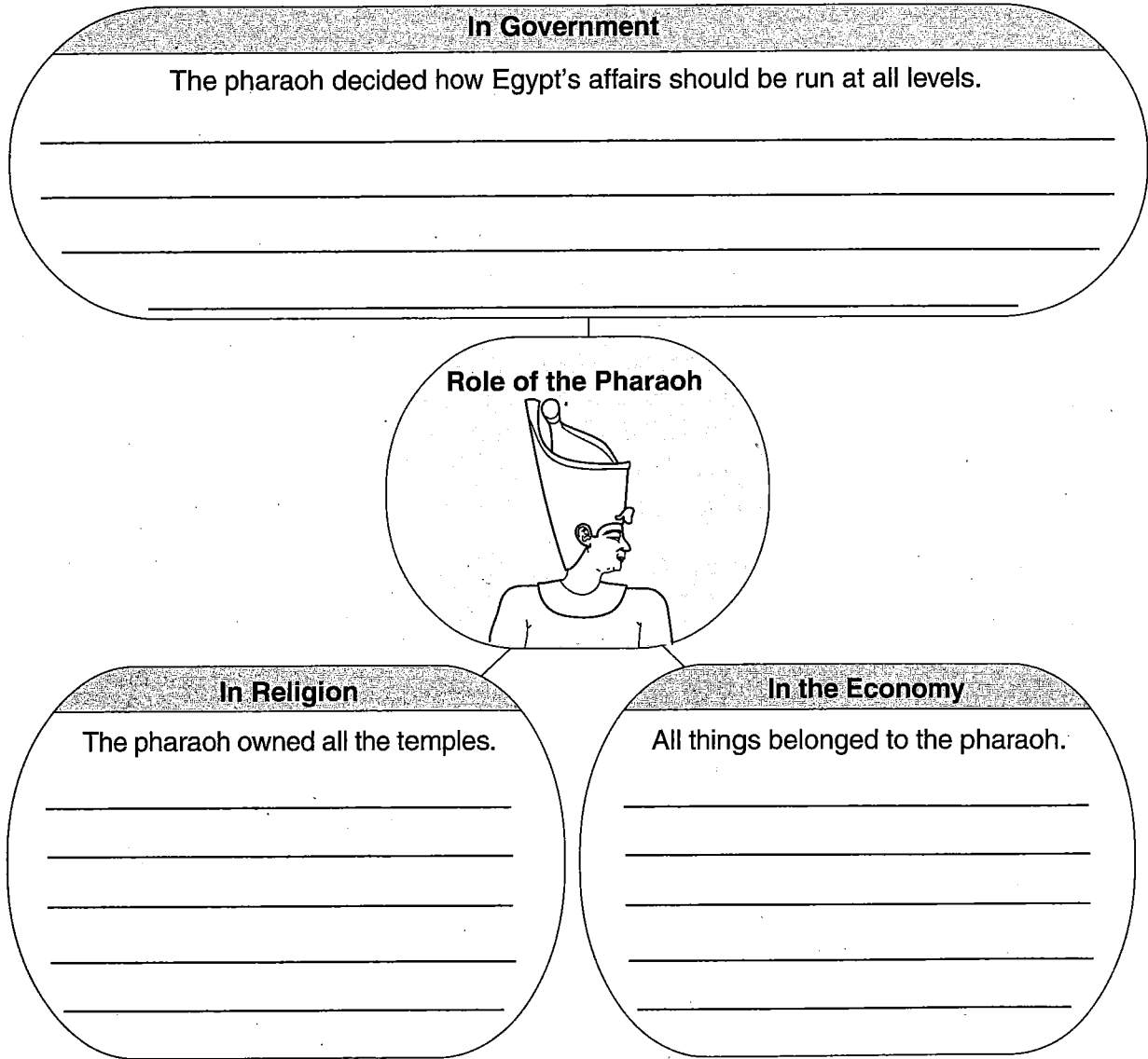


# The Kingdoms of Egypt

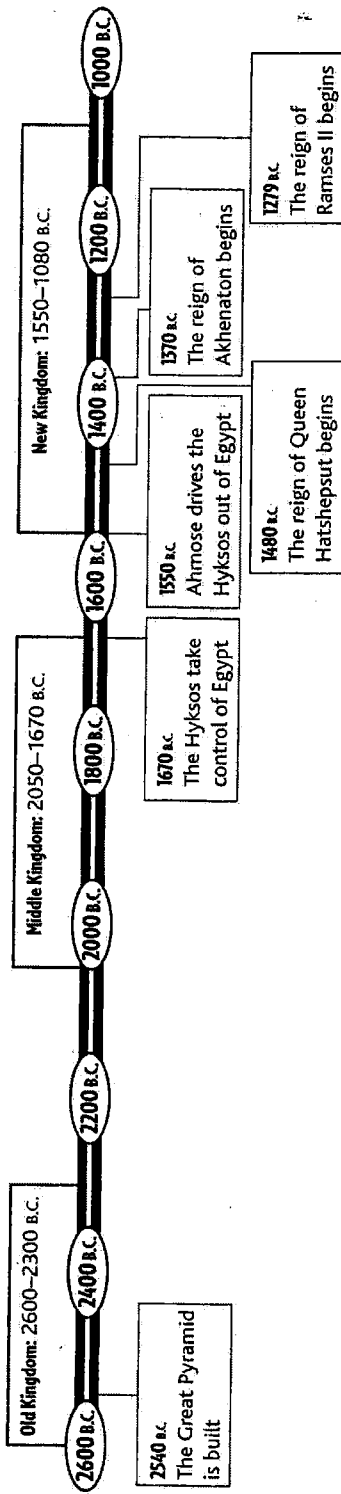
