200 B.C.E. Buddhism came to China and central Asia

70 C.E. Jewish Temple destroyed by Roman soldiers

1600 B.C.E. Nomadic tribe of Israelites believed in one god

1933 C.E. Genocide of 6 million Jews

1200 B.C.E. Laws from God become basis of Judaism

1 C.E. Jesus challenged authority of Jewish priests

312 C.E. The Roman emperor became a Christian

1500 C.E. Explorers of America converted people to Christianity

588 B.C.E. Idea of monotheism emerges

610 C.E. Islam became a new religion. The followers are Muslims.

500 B.C.E. The prince Gautama began teaching Buddhism

1054 C.E. Roman Catholic and Eastern Orthodox churches split

1517 C.E. Protestants broke off from Catholic teachings
